## President's message

Dear Fellows,

Do you still remember the 12th of May last year? It was the inauguration of the Provisional Academy of Nursing (PHKAN) and the conferment of the first cohort of Fellows (i.e., a total of 1,496) affiliated in its 13 Colleges. Amongst these 13 Colleges, the Hong Kong College of Education & Research (HKCERN) was one with 57 fellows conferred. Within such conferment of Fellowship, 10 of our Fellows were entitled and designated to be [FHKAN (Education & Research)], and the other 47 Fellows to be [FHKAN (Education & Research – Education)]. With this Fellowship, I think you may ask yourself what you can get from, or may consider what you can offer to the HKCERN or PHKAN? Two kinds of thinking are fine and reasonable.

What can you get from HKCERN or PHKAN? The HKCERN was set up to support the PHKAN, which aspires to eventually become a statutory body to govern advanced and specialized nursing practice, research and education. We hope to build a critical mass of nurse specialists recognized through credentialing and to act as an expert group to impact health care services, as well as to influence local health care policies. The PHKAN represents an exciting nursing family that accommodates 14 or more specialties; and one of them is Education and Research. The HKCERN or PHKAN is well represented in the levels of government policy committees such as currently, the strategic review on healthcare manpower planning and



professional development hosted by Food and Health Bureau. You would also enjoy seeing a few photographs in this inaugural newsletter, showing the involvement of HKCERN or PHKAN in different occasions.

Would you like to participate more in HKCERN or PHKAN? We would like our Fellows to support the HKCERN in ways that best suit them. Fellows can act as a mentor for our upcoming Members, join our work-groups, and/or help us teach in programs offered by the HKCERN. Fellows can simply participate in any of our activities, which is already a great sign of contribution!

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### **Activities' Highlights**



#### Health Carnival (14 April 2012)

The workshops were taught by Dr. Marie Tarrant, Associate Professor of School of Nursing at The University of Hong Kong, who has researched and published extensively in the use of MCQs.
