



At the beginning of the scientific meeting, the Undersecretary, Food and Health Bureau, Professor Sophia Chan, delivered opening remarks to our Fellows. Prof. Chan shared current trends about healthcare policy development in Hong Kong and resources allocated for promoting primary health care via research.

The two invited speakers of the scientific meeting were Rev. Van Wai-chuen Lo and Ms. Lucy Chung. Rev. Lo is an Associate General Secretary of the Association of Hong Kong Hospital Christian Chaplaincy Ministry Ltd. The topic of his presentation was: 'Holistic Nursing -- to Care with Soul'. Ms. Chung is a Family Therapist and Somatic Experiencing Practitioner (Trauma Institute). She is also the Director of Health Care & Communication Consultants Ltd. 6th December, 2014 Professional visit to the Apprentice Jockeys' School of Hong Kong Jockey Club



A total of 10 Fellows visited the Apprentice Jockeys' School (AJS) of Hong Kong Jockey Club which was established in 1972. The mission of the school is 'to ensure its students become successful jockeys by providing an all-rounded education with emphasis on horsemanship, sportsmanship, knowledge about the local community and international issues, health and exercises, and most important of all, integrity'. During the visit, the participants were provided with opportunities to know more about the certificate racing programme, training stages for trainees and their daily life. The participants also had an opportunity to feed carrots to horses and visit the school and dormitory for the trainees.

A PHKAN Fellowship Network was organized to provide a better understanding of the Voluntary Health Insurance Scheme (VHIS) and to explore the potential APN roles in the forthcoming VHIS. Dr. Regina Ching and Ms. Elaine Chan were invited as speakers. Dr. Ching is the consultant of Department of Health and she introduced the colorectal cancer screening pilot programme in her presentation. Ms. Chan is the deputy chairman of task force on health care reform, for The Hong Kong Federation of Insurers. The topic of her presentation was 'How nursing services can facilitate VHIS'. An open forum followed the two presentations and Fellows actively participated in the discussions.
